

Recess Behavior Expectations

- A happy and safe place to learn

I am Erlund. I am here to speak to you about the rules around entering and exiting our building and having a safe and happy recess.





<u>Before the</u> <u>Morning Bell:</u>

- RVS students wait outside until the bell rings
- Students can wait with a parent in the common area
- Grade 3,4,5 and 6 students will line up in designated areas.





As you Enter our School:

 Boots and dirty shoes are to be placed neatly on the boot racks.

 Grade 7 and 8 students can wear their shoes into the school as long as they are clean and dry.







Once you are dismissed from class for recess:

- Use the washroom if you need to
- Stop at your locker and dress appropriately for the weather
- Head directly outside and stay outside until you hear the bell ring.



 If you are in our building before the first bell, during recess or after dismissal without permission from a staff member there will be a consequence for not following the rules.

Boundaries

There are a few areas where you should not be:

- Around any sheds
- Around the Greenwood Neighborhood Place building
- Near the Art Center, Learning
 Centre or Cosmetology building
- High School parking lot
- Outside the fence line.





Recess activities should be helpful not hurtful. For everyone involved they should be:

- safe
- fun
- follow all of the school rules .







Activities at recess cannot be videoed or photographed by a student unless it is part of a staff approved - project.









If you get injured or have a problem on the playground during recess:

- 1. Locate the nearest supervisor and they will help you out.
- 2. You may be asked to go to the office as a consequence or to get help. If you require help to get there, the supervisor may assign a friend to help.
